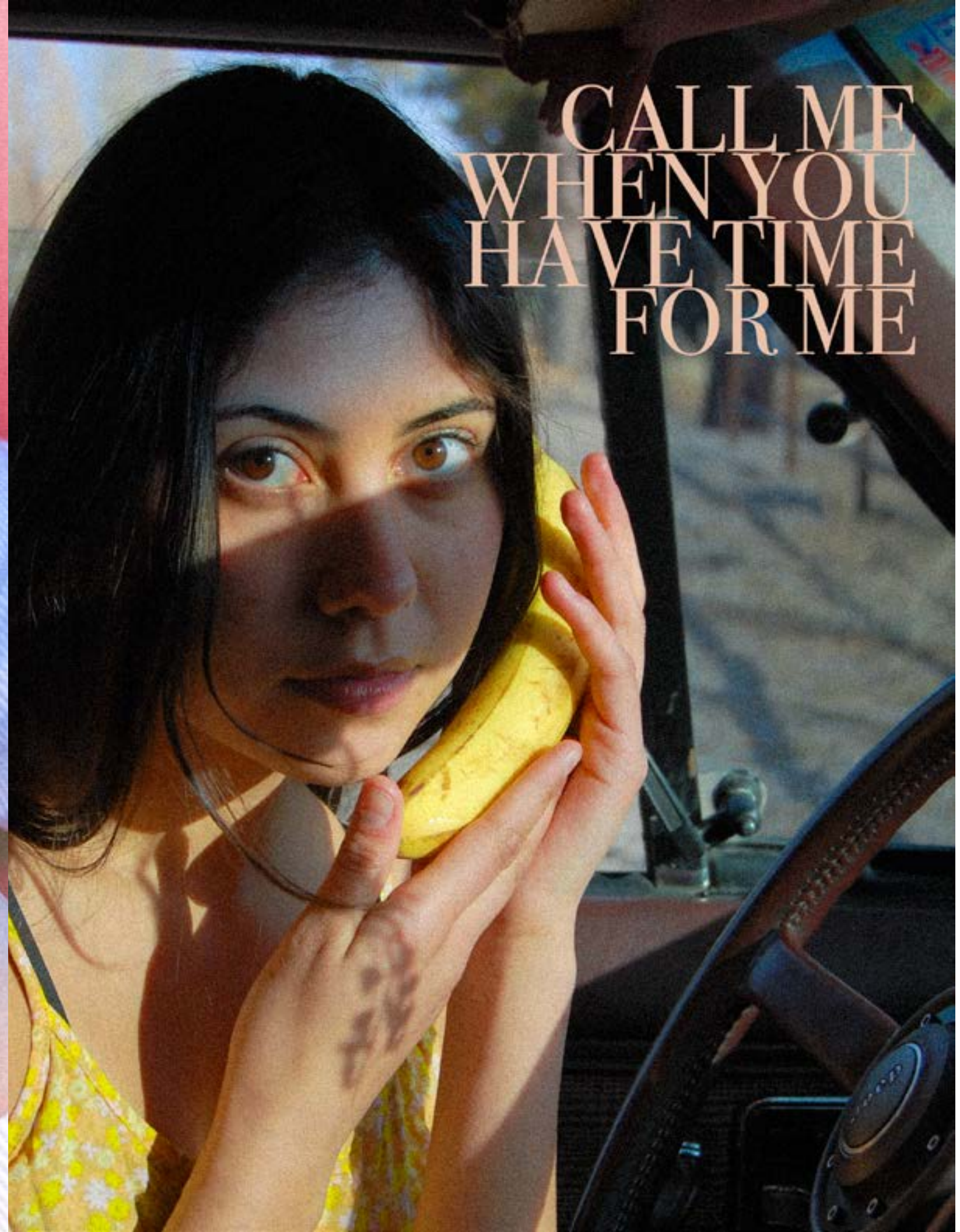

"I love listening to Everything Goes w/ Emma, I get so much inspiration from how relatable she is and she's simplistic, and cool"



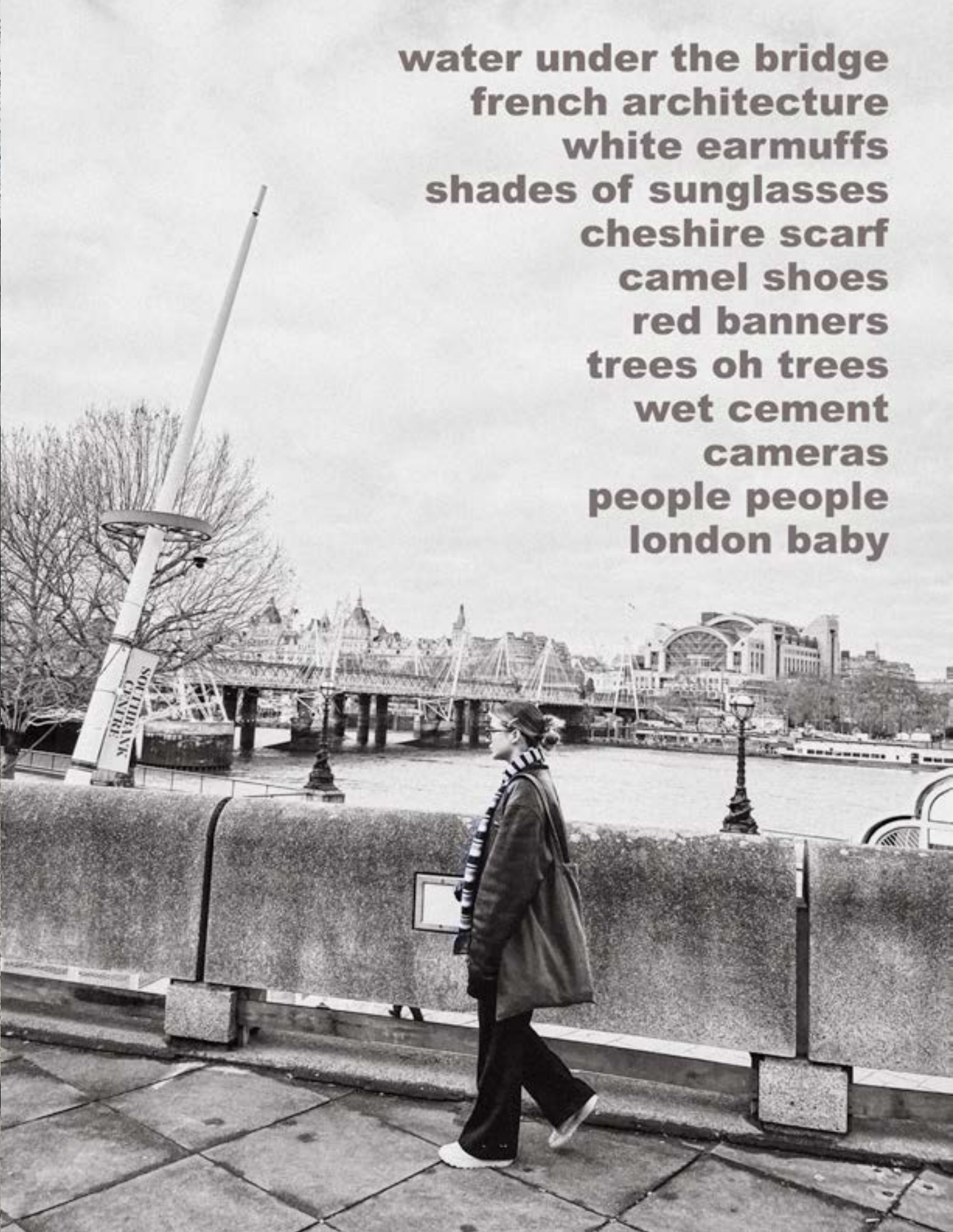

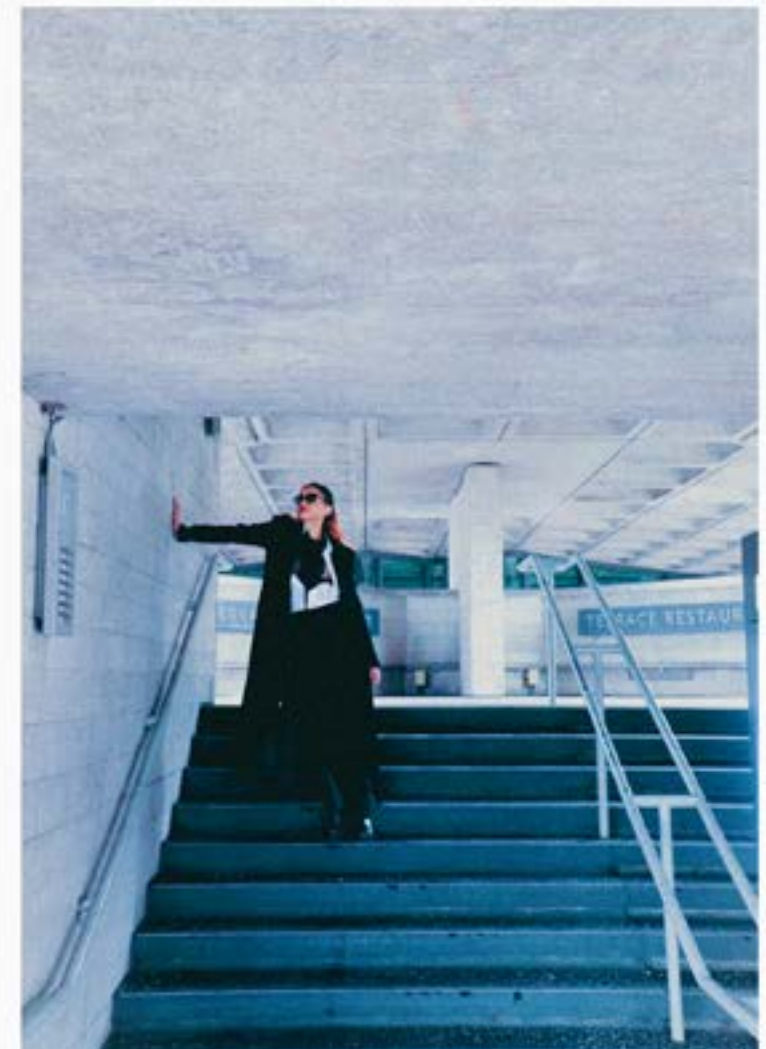

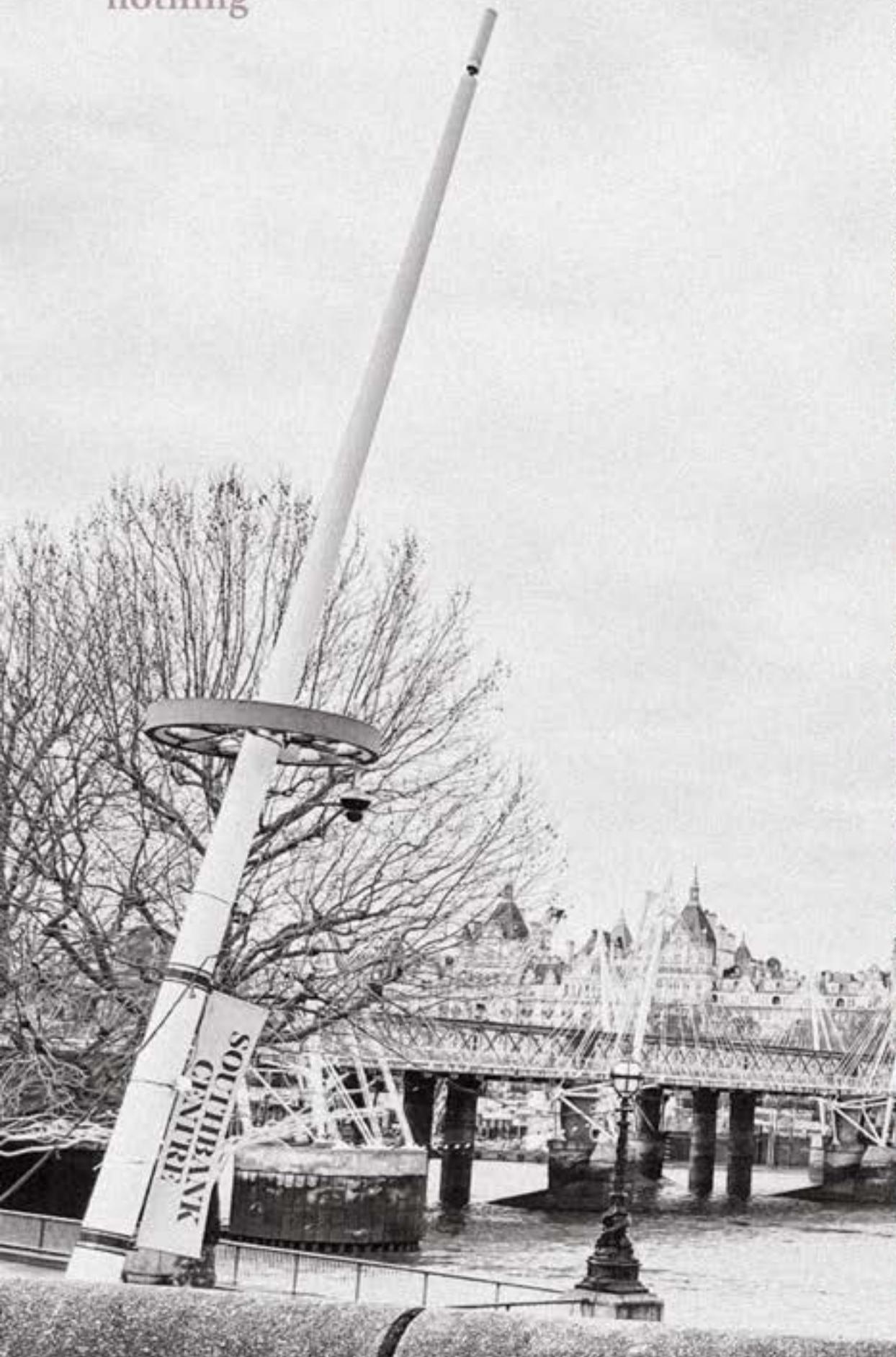
